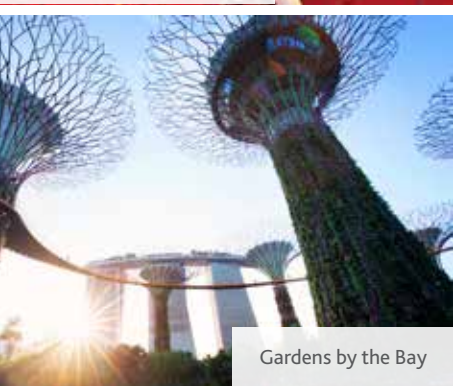

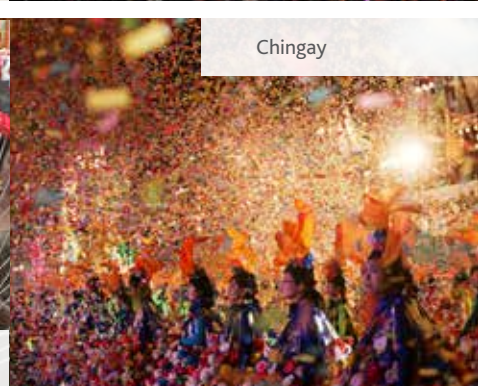

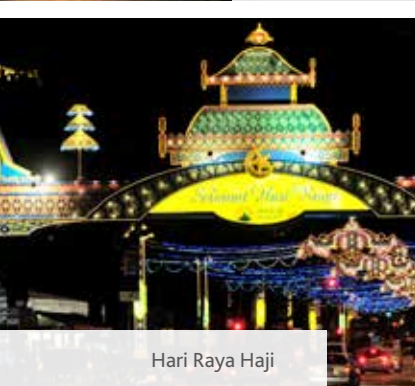

James Cook University is EduTrust Certified. The EduTrust certification scheme is administered by the Committee for Private Education (CPE), a part of SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG). EduTrust requires all students to be covered under a Fee Protection Scheme. In James Cook University, this is provided through an insurance protection scheme. Further, EduTrust also requires that the students must be covered under a medical insurance coverage which has provision for hospitalisation, surgery and treatment costs throughout their course duration. James Cook University will advise in the Standard Student Contract the total amount of insurance payable.

The English Language Preparatory Program not only prepares students with the linguistic skills for success in James Cook University higher education courses, the program also equips students with 21st Century soft skills for the workforce and life-long learning. These skills include critical thinking, collaboration, information literacy, technological literacy, leadership and social skills. The program also provides students with the chance to acquire cultural competence through interactive learning with students from many different cultural backgrounds.

This program helps students in the following ways:

- Enhances students' abilities in reading, writing, speaking and listening in English

Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours)

Students are required to complete 6 subjects, including an individual research thesis in a chosen area of specialisation. After this 1-year course, graduates are eligible for provisional registration with the Psychology Board of Australia. Graduates of this course who wish to become fully registered as psychologists in Australia must complete in addition to this course two years of supervised practice in the field or an accredited Master degree (e.g., Master of Psychology), which includes one year of supervised practice.

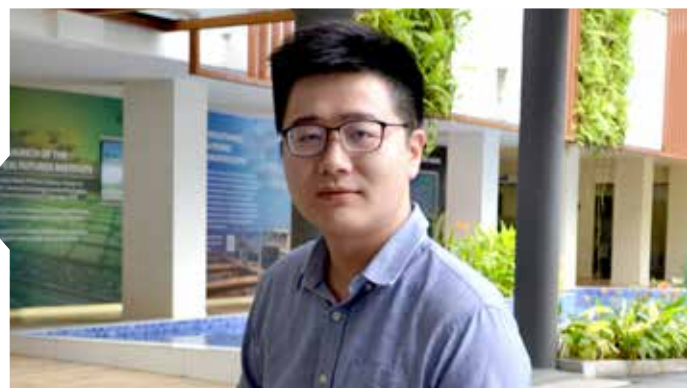

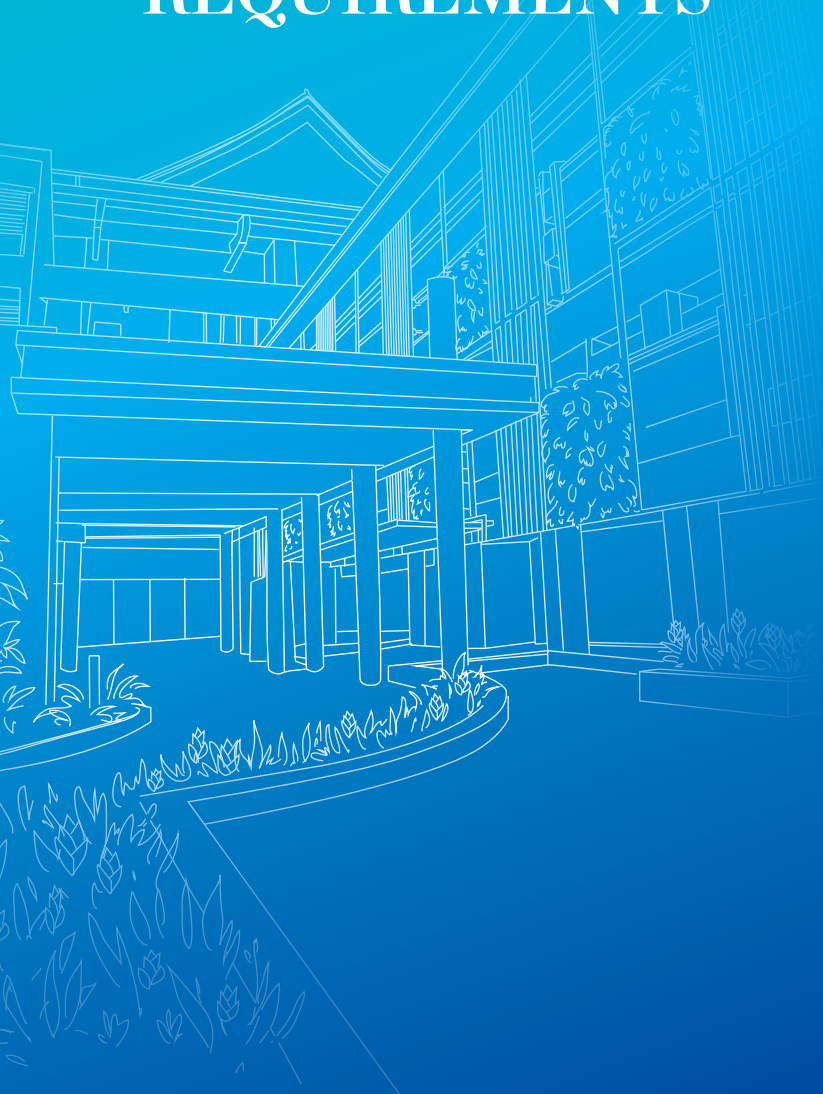
