

Our International Year One programme helps you to study an undergraduate degree at Teesside University, even if you don't meet the entry requirements. With this programme, you will develop your English language and subject knowledge in order to get the most out of your university degree.

In addition to this, after completing the programme you will progress directly to the second year of your degree in order to graduate within just three years. As well as being able to get a head start in your future career, you will also benefit from only three years of affordable tuition fees and living costs.
