





## **ADMISSIONS**

General admission requirements for Camosun's academic programs are as follows:\*

High school graduation or be 19 years old on the first day of classes.

English proficiency (one of): \*\*

- » BC high school English 12 or English Studies 12 or equivalent with final grade of C+ or better
- » IELTS (Academic) score of 6.0 overall (no sub-score less than 6.0)
- » TOEFL iBT score of 78 overall (no sub-score less than 19)
- » PTE Academic score of 54 overall (no sub-score less than 50)
- » Cambridge Assessment of English: C1 Advanced score of 174 overall (no sub-score less than 169)
- » CAEL CE score of 60 overall (no sub-score less than 60)
- » GTEC CBT score of 1200 overall (minimum sub-scores: Reading 325; Writing 270; Speaking 260; Listening 335)
- » Duolingo English Test (DET) score of 105 for General Admission to most Certificate and Diploma programs, and Bachelor of Business Administration programs (exceptions: Nursing and certain other Health-related programs). Score of 115 for admission to Post-Degree programs (all majors) and Degree programs offered by Centre for Sport and Exercise Education.
- » Recognized ESL pathway partner certificate

# HOW TO APPLY

#### 1. APPLY ONLINE

Submit online application through EducationPlannerBC (pay \$100 non-refundable application fee). Make sure to submit supporting documents as well.

Supporting documents may include:

- Transcripts (high school/post-secondary). Scan of official documents is acceptable to submit with application. Official, sealed transcripts must be received by Camosun International. If a supporting document is in a language other than English, please provide a certified English translation.
- Proof of English proficiency
- Scan of passport (pages showing photo, personal information, and signature)
- Scan of study permit (if applicable)
- Program-specific documents (if applicable)



#### 2. RECEIVE LETTER OF ELIGIBILITY

Once your application has been reviewed, and if we determine we can offer you a seat in the program, you will receive a Letter of Eligibility and details regarding your Tuition and Fee Deposit. You must pay the tuition and fee deposit in order to receive the Letter of Acceptance, which is required to apply for a study permit (and entry visa if necessary). The Tuition and Fee Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable.\*

#### WORKING WITH **CONSULTANTS**

Camosun works with a number of qualified consultants abroad who provide education counselling services to international students.

If you choose to work with an education consultant, Camosun recommends that you do careful research to ensure you find one who will meet your needs.

#### 3. RECEIVE LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Submit your application for your study permit (and entry visa if necessary) to your local visa office, and make your travel arrangements to come to Canada in time for the New Student Orientation.
