The School's courses centre on audiovisual storytelling through different media from print to TV. We have committed teaching by professional practitioners who have experience working with the BBC, ITN and Reuters.

We host regular speakers, masterclasses and workshops with big names and casting agencies from the media industry. There are regular visits to media institutions in London, with its thriving creative industries activity and we are committed to help students find work placements in this sector.

Life Sciences

Staff are active in exciting research areas such as cancer biology, neurodegenerative diseases, microbiology, environmental biology and biotechnology. Our courses not only meet the demands and expectations of the industry but also equip you with the right skills to ensure you will be highly employable when you graduate.

Psychology

You will develop skills that are highly desirable to potential employers, including the ability to: conduct research; project manage; critically analyse; communicate; and develop teamwork. You will have the opportunity to be involved in research projects, volunteering and attend and present at conferences to further explore the field of psychology.



Faculty of Health & Social Sciences (HSS)

Facilities

Our healthcare students will benefit greatly from our simulation suites, which include an operating theatre, ward area, high fidelity mannequins, and much more. Most recently we have added to our simulation capacity with our new Simulance, a fully functioning ambulance.

Healthcare

By embedding practical learning in our courses, we aim to provide you with a better understanding of the theoretical concepts you learn in lectures. You will be taught by experienced professionals in a modern working environment to build your knowledge and confidence, and help you develop autonomy and independent practice. You will gain valuable knowledge on the UK healthcare system which will encourage you to consider feasible changes to practice when comparing it with healthcare in your country.

We also offer a wide range of teacher training courses which provide qualified teacher and qualified early years teacher status. Our English language provision is accredited by the British Council.

Facilities

The Gateway building at our Bedford campus offers you teaching environments which support our student-centred approach to learning and the integration of the latest technology. Our sports facilities include a gym, strength and conditioning suite and AstroTurf in addition to the international standard sports arena, which seats up to 400 spectators. The six purpose-built BASES Accredited sport and exercise science laboratories, nutrition research kitchen and two molecular and cellular physiology labs promote excellence in both teaching and research. The environmental chamber is used both for research and by top-class athletes for training and preparation for competition in different climates.

Our Sports Therapy and Rehabilitation Centre includes three clinical teaching spaces, a sports injury clinic, a rehabilitation room, a community exercise clinic and a private room for consultations and treatments.

Education

The faculty has well-established links with more than 500 schools so that you can benefit from a practical and relevant learning experience. We offer specialisms in a range of areas. Students from other countries have the opportunity to gain experience in local schools, and compare their native country's education system with the UK's.

English Language, Linguistics, TEFL

Our undergraduate courses offer the opportunity to study language and linguistics across a broad spectrum which will prepare you for careers in a range of professions, including speech and language therapy, lexicology, media, broadcasting, legal and forensic intelligence. The TEFL (Teaching English as a Foreign Language) pathway will allow you to gain an additional qualification that gives you British Council certification.

Sport Science and Physical Activity

Recent investments in state-of-the-art laboratories will provide you with the best sporting education possible and create numerous opportunities for engagement in experimental work. We have an extensive network of links with sports organisations and employers, ensuring that your studies incorporate the most up-to-date knowledge and ideas. Our internationally recognised research combines specialist knowledge focusing on nutrition, exercise, and therapeutic strategies to improve global health awareness and quality of life across multi-cultural communities.

Gain practical experience

Practical experience will be a vital tool in your life after university. Studying at Bedfordshire will give you the opportunity to put your skills to the test. Media students can replicate what happens in industry through Media Junction, which provides opportunities to specialise in short promotional films. Our students are paid to set-up, shoot and edit real projects for real clients, and build up impressive portfolios of work. Art & Design students can join the Guildford Street Press, and take on the roles of designers, illustrators, writers, editors, and publishers for both internal and external clients.

Our Sports Therapy students undertake placements in our free Sports Therapy Clinic, which enables them to gain hands on experience in assessing and treating musculoskeletal injuries, as well as providing sports massages. In addition, Law students are able to work within our Law Clinic and the Refugee Legal Assistance Project alongside academics, qualified lawyers and local advisers, on live cases to enhance their experience of legal practice.

Careers & Employability service

Our award-winning Careers Service offers specialist employability advice, access to a wealth of career information and online resources, coaching on CV-writing and interview skills, help securing part-time work, internships and volunteering opportunities. You can continue to access this service even after you graduate.

Entry and English language requirements

Undergraduate degrees (BA/BSc/BEng)

You will need to have completed your high school education, have a pass equivalent to two UK A level passes, and have the required English language qualification.

Postgraduate taught courses (MA/MSc/MBA/LLM)

You will need to have a good honours degree, or equivalent qualification in an appropriate subject from a recognised university or HE institution. We also consider candidates with other relevant qualifications and individuals with appropriate work experience. You will also need the required English language qualification.

Formal English language tests accepted

The University accepts the following qualifications as satisfying the English Language requirements for entry to a Bachelor's or Master's degree:

- IELTS overall score of 6.0 with a minimum 5.5 in each element
- Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE Academic) – Listening: 59, Reading: 59, Speaking: 59, Writing: 59
- Cambridge Certificate in Advanced English, minimum grade C (each element must be at 'weak' or above)
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English, minimum grade C (each element must be at 'weak' or above)

1. Make your application

Submitting your application

You must include:

- Photocopies of your official academic qualifications (certificates and transcripts, including proof of English language proficiency, such as IELTS)
- A one page personal statement detailing why you want to study your chosen course in the UK, why at the University of Bedfordshire and how it will fit in with your future career plans
- A photocopy of your current passport's photo page
- Copies of any UK visas you have held (including any refusals from any country)

If you have previously studied in the UK you must also include CAS letters, certificates and transcripts, UK visas and visa refusals from any country.

2. Wait for your application to be processed

Your application will normally be processed within ten working days but may take longer during busy periods.

3

3. Receive a decision

If your application is successful, we will email you (or your agent) a conditional offer letter. Your letter will outline all the conditions you will need to meet in order to be officially accepted.

4

4. Fulfill your conditions

Fulfilling the conditions on your conditional offer letter will usually include providing financial documents, and paying a deposit or providing proof of sponsorship in order to progress onto a Skype interview with a member of our team.



5

5. Wait for us to complete financial checks

Your financial documents must be checked to make sure they meet UKVI requirements. We will contact you if further evidence is required, and once they are approved.

6

6. Visa application advice

After arranging a suitable time with you, we will contact you via Skype to help you prepare for your visa application interview.

7

7. CAS letter

If you are successful and have fulfilled all the conditions on your conditional offer letter, we will issue your Confirmation of Acceptance to Study (CAS) letter via email to you or your agent. Please note, you must have paid a minimum of 50% of your first year fees in order to receive your CAS.

8

8. Visa application

You are likely to be interviewed by an Entry Clearance or Visa Officer so make sure you have researched all the details about your course of study, including location and accommodation.

9

9. Book your flights and accommodation

Once your visa has been granted, you can book your flights and accommodation.

10

10. Arrival

To ensure a successful start, please arrive in time for your induction. Before you arrive we will email you a New Student's Guide so that you are prepared and know what to expect during your first days on campus. Please note, you must pay a total of at least 65% of your first year fees at registration to officially become a University of Bedfordshire student.
